As part of the educator evaluation, schools in Utah are asked to seek input from various stakeholders, including students in grades K-12, about the educational environment in schools and individual classrooms ([53G-11-507](#)).

The survey asks students for their perspective about student engagement, academic support, school and classroom safety, and the school and classroom learning environment. The survey is anonymous and subject to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. Sec. 1232g. It is administered in November of every year. Survey data are reported to district and school leadership as well as individual licensed educators as group responses. No individual responses are reported. Participation in the survey is always optional and is never a part of any academic grade or participation requirement. There is no penalty for participation or lack of participation in the survey.

The Jordan School District Evaluation, Research & Accountability Department uses Qualtrics to collect and house the survey data. The Evaluation, Research & Accountability Department will analyze the results and disseminate aggregated reports to school and district leadership.
