

## **Parking at Riverton High School**

1 Permit per Household. \$20.00 for a permit. Construction for some additional spots will begin soon, east of the Tennis Courts.

- 1. Your student permit allows you to park in student parking <u>only</u>. Students are not allowed to park in handicapped, staff parking or visitor parking (not even for five minutes). Parking or driving on the lawn causes damage to sprinkler heads and is considered vandalism. Student stalls are <u>yellow</u>. If you park in a yellow stall you won't have to worry about getting a ticket as long as you have a current parking decal in your window. <u>Students purchasing a parking permit are not guaranteed a parking stall</u>. There is a limited number of stalls. There is off campus parking along 27<sup>th</sup> West give yourself time to walk 5-10minutes. Do not park in the neighboring businesses. RHS is not in charge of their lots. Towing is a possibility.
- 2. Parking passes are required in order to park on campus. If you park on campus without a current decal <u>you will get a ticket</u>. Parking tickets are \$20.00. If you pay your parking fine within five days you can reduce your fine to \$10.00. Tickets can be paid online by going to our home page (Rivertonhigh.org) under "Resources". The parking decal must be applied to the inside lower left-hand corner of the front windshield (driver's side). Do not park in any school lot until your issued sticker is appropriately attached. Your decal is valid only for the vehicle for which it is registered. It must be directly adhered to your window. It cannot be taped or placed in a plastic sleeve. You may not move the decal from one vehicle to another.
- 3. Vehicles that are parked illegally may be booted. Vehicles that have multiple tickets may be booted. The boot fine is \$100.00. Parking privileges may be revoked after **three unpaid citations or any inappropriate driving incidents**.
- 4. It is illegal for any vehicle to contain drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons, stolen property, etc. while parked on school property or during a school activity. Schools have the right to search vehicles and seize illegal or inappropriate materials.
- 5. Reminder about parking on the Driver's Ed Range: Parking stalls on the Driver's Ed Range are painted purple as a reminder to students that they need to move their cars immediately after school. Vehicles with valid permits may park on the Driver's Education range provided they remove their vehicles by 2:45 each school day. The Driver's Ed program needs the range cleared so they can begin their classes. Cars on the range may be towed at owner's expense after 2:45.
- 6. It is the student's responsibility to obtain a temporary permit in the main office if circumstances warrant it. Temporary permits are only issued to students who have purchased a parking sticker. A fine of \$20.00 is placed on your Skyward account until the temporary permit is returned.
