March 13 <sup>th</sup>	Junior ACT Day
NOW - April 1st	Apply to SLCC if you plan to take a CE class next year. Priority will be given to students who have an "S" number by the April 1st deadline.
April 19 <sup>th</sup>	Master Schedule published
April 24th	Schedules released in Skyward
April 29 <sup>th</sup>	Arena will open for Seniors at 3:00 pm
April 30th	Arena will open for Juniors at 3:00 pm
May 3rd	Arena open for all students
July 1st - 5th	Arena Closes for Skyward Rollover
July 6th	Arena reopens
July 26th	Arena closes and will not reopen – Schedules will be finalized for next year



# Co-Curriculum Courses

## Incoming Juniors only

- ▶ US History and English 11 - back to back course
- ▶ Team taught by History and LA teacher
- ▶ Projects and lessons are coordinated
- ▶ Research/Reading and assignments will be a collaborative lesson that will have joint grading efforts to reinforce the curriculum in both subject areas

# Online Classes

- ▶ If you are attending Kings Peak you can only take **3 classes** there to remain an RHS student. If you have 4 or more, you will be a KPHS Student.
- ▶ Use the KPHS place holders in your requests
  - ▶ **Kings Peak Year 01551, 01552, 01553, 01554**
  - ▶ **Kings Peak Semester 01561, 01562, 01563, 01564, 01565, 01566, 01567, 01568**
- ▶ If you want classes for Kings Peak High School visit <https://kingspeak.jordandistrict.org/> and speak with your counselor.
- ▶ If you are going to take a course with the state online program let your counselor know, so they can put placeholders in
- ▶ In all cases please see your counselor so your schedule can be adjusted accordingly.

# Work Release

- ▶ Juniors can have up to 2 periods of work release
- ▶ Seniors can have up to 4 periods of work release
- ▶ You need to work an average of 5 hours per week per class period of work release
- ▶ You **must** be able to turn in a **pay stub** to show that you worked the required hours
- ▶ NO cash paying jobs
- ▶ Pick up the application in the counseling center

# How to register for work release

- ▶ Step 1 - Request the number of periods you would like to have work release by requesting the work release course number. Use different codes for each class requested. (A combination of year long and semester can be used.)

**02190-02191 Year long**

**02192 - 02197 Semester**

- ▶ Step 2 - Complete the Work Release Agreement Form - signatures from you, parents and work supervisors are required - and submit it to the work release teacher or your school counselor starting in **August**.
- ▶ The work release agreement form needs to be submitted in order for you to pass the class. Please make sure you take care of this in August!

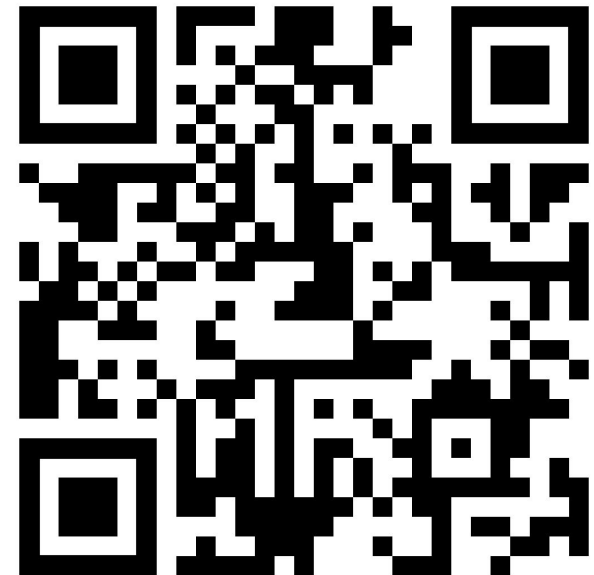
# If you would like Work Release - Fill out this form!

# JATC

- ▶ February 29th- JATC Applications due. Visit [www.jordantech.org](http://www.jordantech.org) to fill out application
- ▶ To add a JATC course, use the following course codes:
  - ▶ **Programs that run the full year select 2 or 4 depending on your program using these codes: 06016-06019 (please check the JATC website to determine how many periods your program will require)**
  - ▶ **Semester codes: 06041-06044**
- ▶ Add in the request for 2 to 4 class periods, depending on your desired course. Many courses have changed - please check out the JATC website prior to selecting periods.
- ▶ **Welding, Hair Design, Barbering, and Medical Assisting will not be listed as a second choice option. If you are hoping for one of these programs make sure to make it your first choice.**
- ▶ You will request AM or PM when you apply.
- ▶ Make sure you have the correct number of classes for the JATC, either 2 or 4 depending on your program.
- ▶ JATC classes will be finalized in Mid-March.

# Audition classes

- ▶ These are sports, music, drama, Drill and Cheer, plus others
- ▶ Add these classes as a course request in skyward. If you do not make the class counselors will change the class later.
- ▶ These classes will be finalized by April. If you make it and have changed your mind after auditioning, you must have your counselor or the registrar remove it before Arena scheduling opens.

# Concurrent enrollment

- ▶ Complete course request in SKYWARD
- ▶ Apply to SLCC and have your “S” number by April 1st. This process could take several days so plan ahead and apply early
- ▶ Go to the Career center for information on how to apply to SLCC or visit [rhsconcurrentenrollment.weebly.com](https://rhsconcurrentenrollment.weebly.com)
- ▶ For English, Math, Biology and Political Science a SLCC placement test is required
- ▶ If you do not test into the class, your counselor will help you find a new class for that period.

# More Concurrent testing

## **The Assessment is:**

- ▶ **You must apply to SLCC and have your S# before you test**
- ▶ **Online, on your own time**
- ▶ **FREE** the first time you take it
- ▶ **Math will require a math and a reading test, English, Political Science, and Biology will require a reading test.**



# Wrap up of what we know

- ▶ You need to make sure your course requests are done by January 22nd. Students who do not have a full 8 credits selected after this date will be called down to the counseling team to add in classes - after that we will add in core classes and you will have to fight on Arena for elective classes. - ▶ Your Schedule will be released to you on April 24th. At that time you will be able to go in and change periods or drop/move classes. Please do not leave holes in your schedule! Your counselor will have to fill holes left after Arena closes. **You do NOT want us picking your classes!!**
