## HIGH SCHOOL OPPORTUNITIES

### Concurrent Enrollment

- Classes that give you both high school and college credit.
- Taught at RHS by high school teachers.
- The maximum cost is a small fraction of the cost of college. (\$40 dollar registration fee, \$5 per semester hour)
- Some courses require a placement exam or qualifying ACT score.
- Any course on the card with a 4-digit number is concurrent enrollment.

### Advanced Placement/AP

- College level courses taught at the high school.
- College credit can be earned based on how well you score on a final exam.
- AP Exams cost \$103 per exam.
- Most rigorous classes that you can take.
