

Summer Driver's Ed:

- Registration for summer opens on March 10th and is first come first serve
- There are two summer sessions (June and July) that are each three weeks, with four mandatory in person days, with the remainder being virtual
 - Mandatory in person dates are: June 8th, 9th, 16th, and 17th, and July 6th, 7th, 13th, and 14th
- Must turn 16 on or before October 15th, 2026







HIGH SCHOOL OPPORTUNITIES: CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

- CLASSES THAT GIVE YOU BOTH HIGH SCHOOL AND COLLEGE CREDIT
- TAUGHT AT RHS BY HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS
- THE MAXIMUM COST IS A FRACTION OF THE COST OF COLLEGE (\$5 PER CREDIT HOUR)
- SOME COURSES REQUIRE A PLACEMENT EXAM OR QUALIFYING ACT SCORE
- ANY COURSE ON THE CARD WITH A 4-DIGIT NUMBER AFTER THE COURSE NAME IS CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT




COURSE REQUEST INFORMATION



STEP 1- LOGIN TO SKYWARD







- JATC application decisions will be finalized by mid-March.
