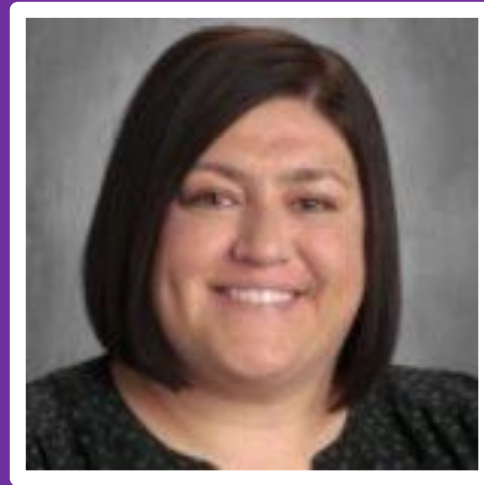

- **January 8th: Course Requests Open**
- **January 22nd: Course Requests Due**
- **February 29th: JATC Applications Due**
- **March and April: Auditions for Audition Style Classes**
- **April 24th:** Schedules will be released
- **May 1st:** Arena opens for Sophomores at 4 PM
- **May 3rd:** Arena opens for all students and remains open during the summer and will close on July 26th (it will close be closed from July 1st through July 5th).

Important Course Request Notes:

- This is not a race to see what classes you get. It is only putting in request for courses you want.
- You will be able to make changes to your course requests until January 25th.
- In the course request scheduler, it will show a class period and semester, this will change when the schedule is finalized.
- Periods and teachers will be added later and you will have a chance to make changes during the Arena window on May 1st.
- **We are only gathering course requests at this time.**

Request Your Classes!

- On the Request Courses tab, there are two options for searching courses:
 - Enter 5 digit course key, click on Search. When course appears, click the course then click “Add Course”
 - Click on a course in Available Courses for [next school year] area, then click “Add Course”Courses will appear in the Selected Course area. Use “Remove Course” to delete courses from your list
- **When complete, verify that your Total Credits = 8.00**
- *Note: if you have an IEP work with your case manager to schedule your classes*

Request 8 Classes!

- **The classes that you request WILL make up your schedule. Only select classes you want to take**
- **If there are any holes in a student's schedule in May after arena scheduling, your counselor will schedule a class that still has seats available during that period.**

Audition Classes

- Auditions for all audition style classes including music, drama, Drill and Cheer are during March & April.
- Add these classes into your requests on Skyward. If you do not make the class, counselors will take it out of your schedule later.

JATC Course Requests

- February 29th- JATC Applications due. Visit www.jordantech.org to fill out application. You will request AM or PM when applying on their website.
- Natural Resources, Intro to Engineering and Intro to Education and are the only programs available for Sophomores.
- To add a JATC course, use the following course codes:
- **06016-06019**
- Add in the request for 2 or 4 class periods. Natural Resources and Intro to Education are 4 periods, Engineering is 2.
- JATC application decisions will be finalized by mid-March.

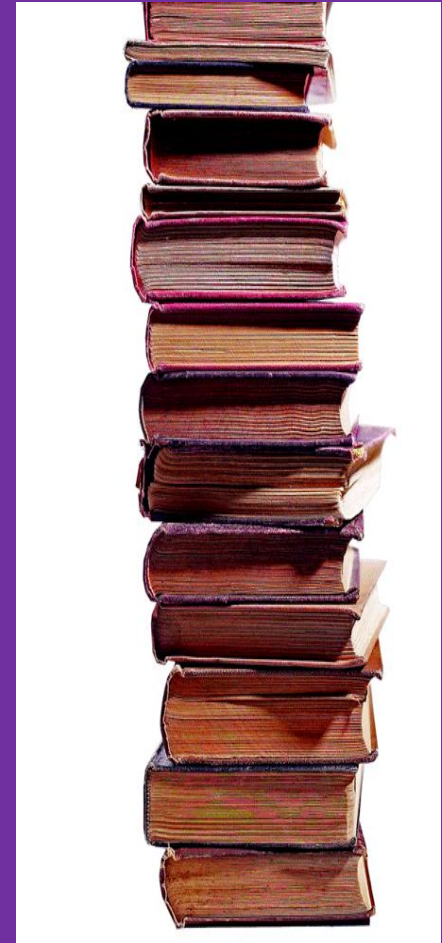
Driver's Education

Enrollment in Driver's Education is based on the date of your 16th birthday. Students should register as follows:

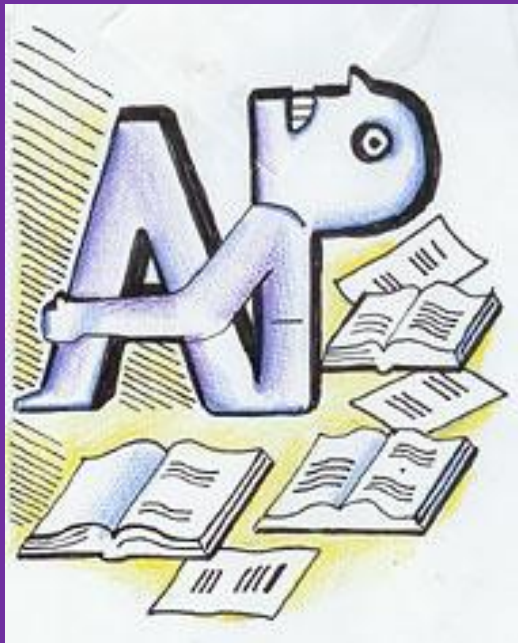
- **1st Quarter: June 1st through Dec. 1st**
- **2nd Quarter: Dec. 2nd through Feb. 20th**
- **3rd Quarter: Feb. 21st through May 25th**
- **4th Quarter: May 26th through Aug. 31st**
- **GET YOUR PERMIT before the 1st day of class!**
- **Summer driver's education class is available for those who will be 16 by Oct. 15, 2024.**

What are Advanced Placement (AP) Classes?

- College level courses taught at the high school.
- College credit can be earned based on how well you score on a final exam.
- Exam fee is \$102 for each AP exam you take.
- AP classes are the most rigorous classes available in the high school.

What is Concurrent Enrollment?

- Classes that give you high school and college credit at the same time.
- College level courses taught by high school teachers.
- The maximum cost is a small fraction of the actual cost of college. (\$40 dollar registration fee, \$5 per semester hour)
- Credit may be applied toward a post-secondary degree.
- Some courses require a placement exam or ACT score.


