

Parents and students,

The day is almost here! The class of 2026 graduation ceremony will be on Wednesday, June 3rd at the UCCU Center in Orem at 6:00PM. As we get closer to that day, please be aware of the some important information.

Graduation Practice

- Tuesday, June 2nd will be graduation practice at Riverton High School. All students that are planning to participate in graduation activities should plan to attend the practice this day. Practice will begin at 9:30 in the auditorium. It will last until approximately 11:00. After practice, we will be serving hamburgers and drinks to all seniors outside near the RHS letters on the northeast side of the building. Students DO NOT need to wear their caps and gowns for practice. However, if students are planning to participate in the Graduation Walk activity after practice, they should bring their caps and gowns.

Graduation Walk

- After graduation practice, you will put on your cap and gown and we will board buses and return to your elementary schools so you can walk the halls and have your former teachers and future Silverwolves celebrate YOU during the Graduation Walk. This is an optional activity and you must sign up in order to participate.
 - Buses leave Riverton High School at 11:30 a.m. on Tuesday, June 2nd
 - You will return to Riverton High School around 1:00 p.m.
 - You must sign up in order to participate.
 - You can find the QR code to sign up posted throughout the school or on the Riverton High Main Page.
 - Students will choose from one of the following three routes
 - Rose Creek Elementary, Midas Creek Elementary
 - Rosamond Elementary, Riverton Elementary
 - Bluffdale Elementary, Mountain Point Elementary

Graduation Ceremony

- Graduates should arrive at the UCCU Center by 5:00PM in their caps and gowns.
- Graduation ceremony will begin at 6:00PM. No tickets are needed for parents, family, and friends to attend.

Graduation Dress Code and Decorum (JSD Policy AA419):

The graduation commencement ceremony is a **formal and dignified in-person** school sponsored activity which has significant meaning for graduates, parents, families, staff, and the community. The commencement ceremony, from the opening of the processional to the completion of the recessional, honors the collective achievement of the graduating class.

In order to maintain the dignity, decorum, propriety, and respect of the commencement ceremony, the following is expected of all participants:

- Conduct, dress and appearance are to adhere to the provisions in this policy and be appropriate for a ceremony of this nature. (Best Dress - i.e. Dress Shirts, Ties, Dockers/Slacks, Dresses or Dress pants. No flip flops or shorts. You should have your cap and gown pressed or steamed to remove the wrinkles. A well-dressed graduating class will make a more classy and memorable experience for everyone.)
- **Graduates are expected to wear the prescribed cap and gown without alterations.**
- **Graduates will be allowed to wear recognized items of religious or cultural significance in a dignified manner.** (Please note that draping flags around your shoulders is not permitted during the ceremony.)
- **School issued and approved tassels, sashes, pins, hoods, cowls, mantles, cords, insignias, or medals signifying achievement, honor, participation, membership, or recognition may be worn.**
