Parking Quiz Answer Key

- 1. C No sophomores may park on campus.
- 2. False A parking permit does NOT guarantee you a parking space.
- 3. False It is never OK to park in faculty, handicapped, off the end of the row or on the sidewalk. If you park illegally you risk your car being booted or towed. The boot fine is \$100 to have the boot removed. The towing fee is approximately \$160.
- 4. False We do not have permission to use the church lot as our overflow parking.
- 5. False The asphalt pad next to the tennis court does not have a base under it that will support the weight of cars. Driving/parking on this pad may cause damage that is expensive to repair.
- 6. True Driving/parking on the lawn is considered vandalism and can result in police action.
- 7. False Decals must be adhered <u>using the adhesive on the decal.</u>
- 8. False Decals must be adhered to the inside front windshield in the <u>lower corner of the</u>
 <u>driver's side.</u> A vehicle which does not have a decal properly attached and displayed in the correct location may be ticketed.
- 9. E Students may park in any parking space painted yellow or on the driving range as long as their car is moved by 2:30pm.
