



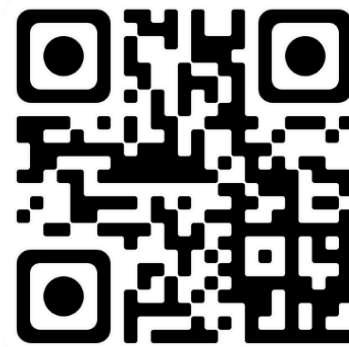

MATH 1030-1060, BIOL 1010, HIST 1700, and POLS 1100 require ACT or SLCC assessment prerequisite scores. Apply to SLCC by <b>February 21, 2025</b> and complete the assessment by <b>March 28, 2025</b> .		
<b>Credit Recovery</b>		
If you have more than 2 quarters of credit recovery, you may be eligible to take a GAP credit recovery class. Visit with your counselor to request assistance.
