Class Change Policy

Class changes are allowed the FIRST 4 SCHOOL DAYS of each semester.

There should be very few schedule changes since students choose their own schedules.

Policy Clarified

Class changes are made during the <u>first 4 days of each</u> <u>semester</u> (2 A days & 2 B Days).

Class changes are made based on seat availability and teacher approval. Any class change that creates an imbalance may be denied. All changes are subject to administrative approval.

A class change after the first 10 days of the quarter will result in the student receiving a No Credit (NC) on their transcript. A new course will not be added until the start of the new quarter.

Drop Dates by Quarter:

Quarter 1: 8/19 - 9/2 Quarter 2: 10/27 - 11/7 Quarter 3: 1/21 - 2/3 Quarter 4: 4/6 - 4/20

*Taking an "NC" in a course could affect graduation credits, NCAA / UHSAA eligibility, and college admissions. Class change requests after the drop date will be limited to level changes. Changes for the following requests should be made before the posted drop dates:

- Dropping a class not needed for credit
- Moving to an online course
- Changing your lunch
- Changing your mind on electives
- Requesting a different teacher
- Adding/dropping work release
- Trying to add a class with a friend
