ONLINE Classes

What classes do I have to take next year?

How do I check graduation requirements?

Log into Skyward <https://skystu.jordan.k12.ut.us/>

1. On the Left Side (blue) panel go down until you see “**Graduation Requirements**” – Click to open
2. Courses you still need to take will have a “RED” number to the left under the “**remaining**” section.
3. Sophomores will typically need the following classes
 - a. English 10 (ALPS students may choose English 11H or AP Lang)
 - b. World History (AP World or AP Euro will count)
 - c. Math 2 or 3 (Math will be progressive based on your current math class – if you have questions ask your current math teacher)

- d. Science (typically students will take a core science – those choices would be Biology, Chemistry, Physics – Students who did not take Biology this year are recommended to take Biology in Sophomore year)
 - e. Fitness for Life (Students who feel they would be able to pass all components of the physical and written portion of the test out may test out once they are in 10th or 11th grade. Students who do not pass on the first attempt will not be allowed to retry)
 - f. Consumer Health 2 (different than the one you took in middle school)
 - g. Drivers Ed (Drivers Ed and Careers are taken based on your birthday – check the registration card for the dates. The Summer Drivers Ed course information will be available on our website soon. It does fill up fast so please keep checking)
 - h. Digital Studies – Student who did not take a digital Studies course in 9th grade may take one of the following classes to fill this requirement: Business Office Specialist, Web Development, Computer Programming 1
 - i. Check Skyward for any additional courses you need for graduation.
 - j. Any class you sign up for over the required courses will automatically fall into your elective section
4. **VERY IMPORTANT – SEE YOUR COUNSELOR If you need to make up any classes.**

Now that you know WHAT you need – let's walk through HOW to add them!

1. Log into Skyward Family and Student Access
 - a. Use your skyward login
2. Click on the "Schedule" link (left panel)
3. Click on the "Request Courses for 2026-27" link (upper right under "course Requests now open")
4. Search for courses by using the scroll bar or "search" field
 - a. To add a course, highlight the course and click the "Add Course" button
 - b. To remove a course, highlight the course and click the "Remove Course" button
5. Add Alternates!!! Adding alternates will help you have a full schedule should the courses you originally selected become full or have scheduling errors.
 - a. Click the "Request Alternates" tab.
 - b. To add an alternate course, highlight the course and click the "Add Course" button.
 - c. To remove an alternate course, highlight the course and click the "Remove Course" button. To prioritize alternate courses, use the arrow buttons.
6. You should register for 8.0 credits and you can register for up to 4 alternate courses.
7. If you do not have a full 8 credits selected your counselor will attempt to help you fill those or may choose courses for you based on graduation requirements and availability.

If you have questions please meet with your current 9th grade counselor. They can answer most of your questions and help you with 4 year planning!
