

RHS Service Animal Policy

This section outlines the rules for service animals at Riverton High School (RHS) and within the Jordan School District.

Policy Overview

- Legal Compliance: Jordan School District and RHS permit service animals to assist individuals with disabilities, in accordance with federal and state law.
- Access: Service animals are allowed in all areas of the school open to students and staff.

Owner Responsibilities

- Control: Service animals must always be under the control of their owner.
- Prior Approval: All service animals must be approved by the district *before* being brought to the school.
- Contact: Owners must see their Assigned Assistant Principal for more information and to begin the approval process.

Student Responsibilities (Interaction with Service Animals)

- Students are required to respect the service animal and its owner.
- Students must not:
 - Pet the service animal.
 - Feed the service animal.
 - Distract the service animal while it is working.

Consequences for Violating Policy

- Violations may result in school disciplinary action.
- Legal action may also be pursued.
