3. Silver Rush Report from student government officers
  - Ivory, Sydney, Ella and Skyler explained the beneficiary of Silver Rush this year, went over some highlights, and presented the committee with the grand total.
  - The Children’s Justice Center was the beneficiary of \$262,229 raised in 22 days.
  - Student government officers listed highlights as being odd jobs, a powerful and personal opening assembly, and the learning experience for LA classes in the Tech Atrium. Skyler mentioned that reminding himself and his fellow students of the ‘why’ made the long days worth it.
  - Tracy Miller expressed how touched and grateful she is for the work done by RHS students to make the community a better and safer place.

  - Ms. Mullen went over the report and explained that JSD now contracts with Success Fund to track all fundraisers. Success Fund can also help with fundraisers, including

making Venmo available. Totals on the form reflect what has been collected through Success Fund, and do not reflect money collected in other ways.

  - Ms. Trimble also read through impressive statistics covering the many meetings between counselors and students.
  - Ms. Waite praised the counseling center's excellent work.

Ms. Waite and Ms. Miller reviewed JSD policy, including how to view titles in the catalog and how parents may restrict student access.
